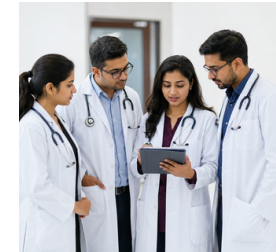

Eligibility Criteria

Any medical graduates or postgraduates (minimum criteria is MBBS).

They should have graduated from MBBS/MD not more than 15 years ago.



Mode of Learning

Online Webinars & Hands-On Workshops

Online webinars

Regular webinars are held online for each module. At the end of each module webinar, we conduct MCQ exams followed by a Q&A session where students can interact with the faculty on their questions about the webinar topics.

Achieving the minimum required marks is necessary, along with at least 80% attendance in online webinars



Workshops

Periodic hands-on workshops are arranged to teach the practical aspects of diabetes care. Attendance at two out of three workshops is compulsory to qualify for the final award of the EPGCD certificate.

In case the International Students are interested, a 3-5-day clinical attachment program can be arranged at a mutually convenient diabetic centre on request, but the workshop clause is optional for them.



Course Structure

- Total duration of the course - 18 months
- The course has 18 live modules delivered by the KOLs in this field.
- The last module is the evaluation module
- A 2000 worded original manuscript on a topic of choice presented during the course modules should be submitted before 17th Module
- Award of EPGCD certificate is provided after the completion of the course during convocation ceremony
